North West Agricultural Workforce Plan

Workshop Summary | December 2020

The North West Agricultural Workforce Plan (the Plan) is one output from the 'North West Job Ready Generation Package'. The Plan describes what industry, government and education and training providers should do to support the growth of a highly valued agricultural workforce in the region.

Workshop Key Points

- The workshop was focused on achieving industry and stakeholder endorsement and commitment for the plan and its actions. The workshop included presentations informing stakeholders about the education and training options including information on the school system, the vocational education and training system, apprenticeships and university.
- The workshop informed participants of training opportunities for agriculture from primary school to university; provided a clear and industry endorsed road-map to fund training for 150 workers; and facilitated stakeholder commitment to implement training in the short term and support
- Feedback from participants was positive. Many commented that more information is needed on:

Funding available from the Tasmanian Government to reduce the cost of VET for employers and learners. RTO's wishing to access Tasmanian Government funding to provide subsidised training in Tasmania must be endorsed by Skills Tasmania.
