Industry Partnerships Program	Aims to improve the way industry works with various stakeholders in the workforce development system through co-designed solutions to whole-of-system training issues. In 2023-24, the program will focus on funding for nationally recognised training-related equipment and resources.	August 2023
Building a Skilled Workforce Jobseeker Fund	Supports training to help Tasmanian jobseekers and people who are looking to upskill or gain new skills outside of their current employment to access training that will lead to improved employment outcomes and job opportunities.	September 2023
Building a Skilled Workforce Existing Worker Fund	Supports training in either skill sets or qualifications for existing workers so they can gain skills and knowledge to assist them to perform their jobs more effectively, efficiently, safely and confidently. New skills and knowledge also supports future career planning and progression.	September 2023
Apprentice and Trainee Training Fund	Subsidises the cost of RTOs delivering nationally recognised qualifications to Tasmanian apprentices and trainees. The program supports employers by providing the skills required to drive competitiveness and economic growth.	October 2023 (rolling grant throughout 2024)
Travel and Accommodation Allowance	Provides a contribution to the total cost of travel and accommodation associated with an apprentice/trainee accessing and participating in off-the-job training.	Ongoing – available throughout 2024
Training and Work Pathways Program	Supports better job and training outcomes for Tasmanians facing disadvantage through targeted job-readiness projects and by building the capacity of RTOs to support disadvantaged learners to a successful training or employment outcome.	May 2024
