<b>Project title</b>	Supporting Trainees to succeed through enhanced interactive learning design
<b>Project description</b>	The project seeks to enhance online learning engagement of trainees enrolled in Certificate III Early Childhood. It will deliver a sample of interactive 'bite size' online training materials based on contemporary learning design principles and reflecting industry needs and practices. With an aim to improve the quality of training including addressing trainee and workplace time constraints. This will be supported through the purchase of technology and equipment that will enable video/recording capability. To ensure capacity building and sustainability, the project will engage a local business specialising in learning design who will develop technical guides and a resource tool kit.
